

Xabregas also has strong stockbroking ties. Established by Terry Hogan and Eve Broadley, of Hogan and Partners, their three Mt Barker vineyards ranging in size from 24 hectares to 51 hectares supply such leading WA labels as Houghton, Howard Park, Vasse Felix and Goundry.

A feature of their products given some of the inflated prices of WA wine, are the moderate charges they have set. For example, the 100 per cent Mt Barker Xabregas reds which were developed over 18 months in new French oak barriques, sell at less than \$15.

" As experienced grapegrowers, we believe we are in a strong position to produce high quality wines which can be offered to consumers at very competitive prices," said Terry. "Our interest is in the fruit component of the wine, so we have set ourselves the challenge to deliver wine enthusiasts a passionate drop without hefty prices."

For the record, Xabregas has been taken from an old family company name.
